PRESS RELEASE

On July 24, 2013, at approximately 7:24 PM, Whitehall Police observed a vehicle southbound on State Route 22 at 59 miles per hour in a posted 45 mile per hour zone. Patrolman Jeffrey Grenier stopped the vehicle on Broadway a short time later.

Upon interview / investigation, the handling officer detected the odor of marihuana emanating from the vehicle, and through further investigation determined there to be a small amount of marihuana and hallucinogenic mushrooms in the vehicle, which the operator of the vehicle claimed ownership of the drug items.

Police subsequently arrested **Max J. Cook**, 20, of West Friendship, Maryland, charging him with the following:

- **Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance – 7th** – Class A Misdemeanor
- **Unlawful Possession of Marihuana** - Violation

Cook was arraigned in Whitehall Village Court and released to appear at a later date.
