PRESS RELEASE

On November 19, 2013 at approximately 10:35 PM, Police were called to a Wheeler Avenue residence for a report of criminal mischief to a vehicle that had just occurred, with the suspect fleeing the area. Police interviewed the complainant at the scene and alerted other area law enforcement patrols of the suspect and vehicle information.

Following a brief investigation, Police arrested **Charles I. Krueger**, 22, of Honey Hill Lane, Granville, and charged him with the following:

• Criminal Mischief – 3rd Degree – Class E Felony

Krueger is alleged to have caused damage to a vehicle by kicking and punching it. Krueger is reported to have been in a previous relationship with the owner of the vehicle and had become upset after seeing a vehicle belonging to the victim's new boyfriend at the residence.

Krueger was arraigned in Whitehall Village Court and remanded to the Washington County Correctional Facility for a lack of \$250.00 cash bail / \$500.00 bond.

The case was handled by Whitehall Police Patrolman Randolph Bevins with assistance from the New York State Police, who located Krueger in the area and turned him over to Whitehall Police.
