## PRESS RELEASE

On April 15, 2013, Police arrested **Jacob T. Chaplin**, 22, of Blinn Street, Whitehall, following an investigation into a reported domestic dispute that had occurred at a village residence on April 14, 2013.

Chaplin was charged with the following:

- **Attempted Strangulation – 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree** – a Class D Felony
- **Reckless Endangerment – 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree** – a Class A Misdemeanor
- **Unlawful Imprisonment – 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree** – a Class A Misdemeanor
- **Criminal Mischief – 4<sup>th</sup> Degree** – a Class A Misdemeanor

Chaplin is reported to have engaged in a domestic dispute with a subject he had been involved in a relationship with, in which he is alleged to have attempted to choke the victim with his hands in addition to damaging multiple items of personal property in the residence, pushing the victim down the stairs of the residence, and restricting the victim's movement from a room inside the residence. The victim sustained minor injuries during the altercation.

Chaplin was arraigned in Granville Court and remanded to the Washington County Correctional Facility for lack of \$10,000 cash bail / \$20,000 bond.

The investigation was handled by Patrolman Randolph Bevins and the arrest handled by Patrolman David Gebo.
