IDENTITY THEFT VICTIM INFORMATION

If you are a victim of identity theft, you should immediately call the three national credit reporting organizations to place a fraud alert on your name and Social Security number.

Identity theft will involve you setting up new credit lines and accounts. The fraud alert will let any company that checks your credit know that your information has been stolen and that they should contact you by telephone to authorize any new credit lines in your name.
